Katie, who will be 19 when she takes part, is currently working in Weston-super-Mare for 'Airbus' on a technical apprenticeship programme and has written the following words on her fundraising page:

In 2015, at just 13 years old, my cousin Jamie suddenly passed away in his sleep due to a cardiac arrest caused by severe myocarditis. The Jamie Loncaster Memorial Fund was set up with CRY ([Cardiac Risk in the Young](#)) to raise funds for local heart screenings that can prevent such tragedies from happening to other families.

With the generosity and support from donors like you, CRY can continue their work in funding awareness, research and free heart screenings to young people aged 14-35 across the UK, growing the total number of young people screened (a remarkable 311,000 to date).

Jamie was incredibly kind, and always lit up the room with his infectious smile and sense of humour - I cherish my memories of him, and continue to miss him dearly every day.
