



Heart Screening Event – October 2025

Over the weekend of 18th & 19th October, the Jamie Lancaster Memorial Fund covered the cost for the **Cardiac Risk in the Young** screening team to return the area and screen the hearts of yet more local young people.

South Hunsley School once again offered free use of the venue and assisted with the promotion, set up and general logistics for the event. As always, many thanks to all those involved at the school.

This screening event saw **192** young people have an ECG heart tracing and the CRY Cardiologist in attendance reviewed every ECG tracing and spoke with each person to discuss their results. Jamie's legacy has now screened an amazing **3,054** young people since the first event back in 2016.

10 young people who attended were referred for a follow up with their GP or further tests with regards to symptoms/family history. Some of the 14 year old attendees were advised to return for a further screening in a couple of years due to their current young age (juvenile heart).

National CRY statistics from over 20 years of screening show that 1:100 people screened will have an irregularity with their heart and 1:300 will have a potentially life-changing condition.
